

## Town of Richford Planning Board

MINUTES – July 1, 2015

Meeting started at 7:06 pm.

Reviewed the June 3, 2015 minutes. Merrill moved and Caskey seconded to accept the June minutes. Unanimously approved.

### OLD BUSINESS:

Nuzzo discussed the Public Hearing held for the Comprehensive Plan update. Two town board members, 10 residents, and 7 Comprehensive Plan Committee members attended the hearing. Very positive response, with constructive input from the Town Board members. Nuzzo integrated the comments and sent an updated version of the Comprehensive Plan with changes shown to the Town Board. Now waiting for the Town Board to agree to a meeting date to review the newest version and hopefully agree on a final version.

### NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion about the CP updated plan. Suggestions for changes/additions include:

Caskey – encourage residents to use bus service if it starts again.

Stuhlmiller - Change gas station to gas station/mini-mart.

Add to local businesses: stove manufacturer, tent rental,

Change “potato” to “seed potato” on page 2.

Replace (remove section about “after 3 absences”) with: inform/alert potential candidates to their obligations to the office.

Section 4.3 graded school – it is the repository of Town history. Emphasize historical aspects of the graded school.

Discussed replacing bullets with numbers – Nuzzo was concerned that this might indicate priorities. Consensus that numbers would be easier to navigate through the document but the bullets are acceptable for the final plan.

Stuhlmiller requested that her name be removed as one of the CPC members.

Stuhlmiller led discussion about the upcoming newsletter and what articles to include. All articles should be sent to Nuzzo by July 6, and the intention is to have the newsletter printed and in the mail by July 10.

Caskey moved and Nuzzo seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting. Unanimously approved.
