

December 10, 2013

Supervisor Wilcox called a public hearing to order at 7:28 p.m. The reason for the public hearing was to find a contractor to demolish and remove the Joyce Hyde property. Three contractors are interested. Whoever is chosen as the contractor is to survey the property and give a report on the structure to the board.

The regular Town of Richford Board meeting was called to order at 7:45 p.m. by Supervisor Wilcox. All Board members were present except Bev and Ricky Brown. Eight townspeople were also in attendance.

The minutes of the November 18, 2013 Town Board meeting and a Public Hearing on December 5, 2013 were presented for review. Councilwoman Herrick seconded by Supervisor Wilcox accepted the amended minutes. All approved.

The Supervisor's and Town Clerk's reports for November 2013 were presented.

Highway Superintendent Holt gave a report for November 2013. He stated that they have hauling sand for next year and he has called regarding the CHIPS money.

The Justice Court report for November 2013 was presented and showed \$3270.00 as being collected in fines. There was a Dog Control and Code Enforcement report given for November 2013.

Charlie Davis gave a Planning Board report for November 2013. He reported on the Rules of Public Ethics project.

Councilman K. Miller, seconded by Councilwoman C. Herrick, made a motion to pay the vouchers on Abstract #12 and that the vouchers on the Abstract are the same ones signed by the Board. The General Abstract includes vouchers A233 through A254 amounting to **check with Martin**. The Highway Abstract includes vouchers DA242 through DA??? amounting to ??. All approved. Vouchers will be paid.

OLD BUSINESS

There was more discussion regarding the Hyde property. Councilwoman Herrick, seconded by Councilman Miller, made a motion to hire Darryl Cross as the contractor to demolish the house on Hyde property. All approved.

Councilman Miller informed the board that he has been working on insurance.

NEW BUSINESS

Councilwoman Herrick seconded by Councilman Miller made a motion to reappoint Victoria Nuzzo to a seven year term on the town planning board. All approved.

Councilwoman Herrick introduced the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the garbage truck procedures be adopted. A roll call vote showed 3 yeas and 0 nays.

Councilwoman Herrick seconded by Councilman Miller, made a motion to hold a special year-end meeting on December 30, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. All approved.

PRIVELEGE OF THE FLOOR

There was a question on a town's person becoming a board member when they have a law suit against the town.

There was discussion regarding using the Pennysaver as the town newspaper.

The town supervisor received a letter regarding casino licenses and asking townships to back the proposal.

Councilwoman Cindy Herrick, seconded by Councilman Ken Miller, made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 9:05 pm. All approved.
