

November 12, 2014

A special Town Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Wilcox on Wednesday, November 12, 2013 at 6:41 pm. Councilwoman Herrick, Councilwoman Holcomb, and Councilman Miller were present. Councilman Brown was absent. One townspeople was also in attendance.

Supervisor Wilcox reminded the board that the 2015 budget must be adopted by November 20, 2014 and the Highway contract expires on December 31, 2014.

Regarding the Highway contract, there was discussion on the vacation time accrual rate and wording in the contract. Councilwoman Holcomb would like to see the vacation time done in chart form for easier understanding.

Discussion followed on the cost of medical insurance and the amount the highway employees pay in. The board would like the contract to state that the employees will pay 25% of the yearly insurance cost for the family plan and 10% for the individual plan.

Councilwoman Holcomb will work up the chart for the vacation time and email it to the board for review and comment and Supervisor Wilcox will investigate the feasibility of the increase in insurance payment by the employees.

Highway Department contract discussion ended at 7:50 p.m.

Review and discussion of the 2015 Town of Richford Preliminary Town Budget began at 7:50 p.m. The budget was reviewed and the following changes were made:

A9060.8 minus \$5,689

A2130 add \$4,000

A2610 add \$2,000

DA 5130.2 minus \$30,000

DA9060.8 minus \$5,688

On the summary sheet change the General surplus amount from \$5,000 to \$20,000 and the Highway surplus amount from \$10,000 to \$70,000.

Councilman Ken Miller, seconded by Councilwoman Cindy Herrick, made the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Richford Preliminary Budget be adopted as the 2015 Town of Richford budget. A roll call vote showed all members voting aye. The 2015 Town of Richford Budget was unanimously adopted.

Councilwoman Herrick, seconded by Councilwoman Roberta Holcomb, made a motion to adjourn at 8:30 p.m.
