Section 1 - 1 Title.

This local law may be known and cited as the "Property Identification Law" of the Town of Richford.

Section 1 - 2 Purpose.

It is the purpose of this local law to promote the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Richford by providing regulations to preserve the peace, good order and safety of the residents of the Town of Richford.

Section 2 - 1 Property Identification.

Property Address Identification Numbers shall be displayed as set forth below:

(a) All principal structures located within the Town of Richford shall display in at least one location, the street number assigned to it by the Town. The number must be prominently displayed on the side of the structure facing the roadway.

(b) In the case where the principal structure is not clearly visible from the street or roadway, the assigned street number shall be displayed:

1. On the mailbox, if the mailbox is within 25 feet of the property access or if the mailbox is directly across the roadway and within 25 feet of the property access; or

2. On a post set on the property, outside the roadway right of way, in a location clearly visible from the roadway. The post shall not exceed five (5) feet in height. The street number shall be displayed on the side of the post facing the roadway.

(c) Each number shall be ARABIC in design and shall sharply contrast from its background. In no case shall script design be used.

(d) When displayed on a structure or post, each number shall be a minimum of five (5) inches in height. When displayed on a mailbox, each number shall be a minimum of four (4) inches in height, and shall be displayed on both sides of the mailbox, so as to be visible from the roadway in both directions.

(e) In the case of new construction, no temporary or final Certificate of Occupancy shall be issued until the Code Enforcement Officer verifies that such street number has been properly installed.

(f) Any structure displaying the assigned street number that is ARABIC in design, a minimum of four (4) inches in height on a structure or post and is in compliance with paragraphs (a) and (b) of this section, as of the effective date of this section, shall be deemed to be in substantial compliance with this section.

(g) Commencing one year from the date of publication of this local law, no street number may be displayed that is inconsistent with the street number assigned by the Town.

Section 3 - 0 Penalties.

Any person or persons who violate any provision of this law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be punished by fine not to exceed \$100.00; each day of any violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4 - 0 Saving Clause.

If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5 - 0 Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect after being passed by a vote of the Town Board, Town of Richford and 10 (ten) days after filing with the Secretary of State.
